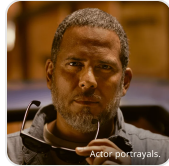

Totally unrelated to the products mentioned here, but I'm going to complain about Fellow.

I have FIVE of the Carter 360 mugs (bought some as gifts, a couple for myself), all of which immediately took on the smell of dish soap. I believe it's mainly the rubber gasket. I've tried hand washing them, baking soda, vinegar, bottle sanitizing products, etc... and still this smell/taste persists so strongly that it's just simply a faulty product.

The taste is so strong that they are unusable. After months trying to fix this issue myself I finally reached out to them, especially after I found out this is a well known issue and a faulty product.

I contacted them with the Amazon order numbers and they responded saying they won't replace the gaskets since they are out of warranty.

That is their right, but you'd just expect better from a company if they cared about their customer and backed their products. We're talking like \$5 of gaskets thrown in an envelope and sent out, to a customer who bought 5 of your mugs and even responded they were disappointed in Fellow and own a full suite of their other equipment.

Don't buy their mugs. If you get one, it might be faulty. If it is, they won't help you.

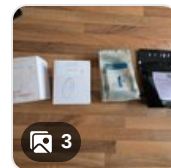
