
# Is there a way to get out of combat quickly when fighting a striking dummy

#### [Question]

Recently I've been leveling different DPS jobs simultaneously. I join queue with the job I want to level and, since the DPS queues often take quite a few minutes to pop, I switch to another job I want to practice and go practice my rotation on striking dummies. The problem is that, if the queue pops while I'm practicing, since I'm in combat with the striking dummy, I can't switch to the job I queue'd with to confirm that I'm ready to enter the instance.

I try to run as far away as I can, and as quickly as I can, from the dummy to get out of combat, but I'm not often in time to break aggro in this way and to switch to the job required. It's even worse if I was practicing the rotation on a dot job like Summoner; no matter how far away I run, while the dots are ticking I can't get out of combat with the dummy.

Is there any faster way to get out of combat with the dummy that I don't know about? Or should I just not stop practing in this way switching between jobs while queue'd?





You can click on the dummy to get its target, then RMB their health bar and click to reset the aggro. This will take you out of combat with them
