i have [dry eyes](#) and started out with dailies like a million years ago and then moved to the night and day 2 week ones in high school and i'm now on 2 week accuvue oasys. the oasys have been my favorite. i work nights so i only wear them once a week so i don't change them as often as i should. i wear my glasses most nights. but overall ive definitely stretched them out to last longer than the year supply. i also can tell a difference if i use different solutions for storage. my favorite is the revitalens. in my experience, if i have the nicer solution, i can get more wears out of my lenses.

my other tip. i just get whatever fits into my allotment for insurance. since i have the same prescription in each eye they let me get an odd number of boxes. then i have them give me a prescription and i order third party. this last round i got from walgreens because they have a 30% off promo for contacts and im an employee so i got my discount on top of the promo.

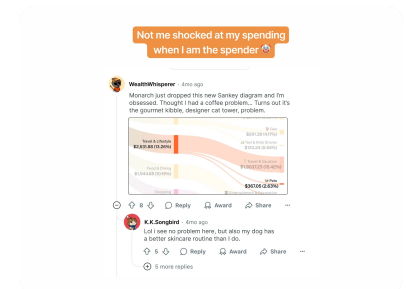

The material and the modality (1-day, 2wk, monthly) CAN'T make much difference on the FIRST day.

If a lens gets dry and scratchy by the end of the day, no eye drops or change in solution will solve that problem. Try another lens.
